

# Dicamba Rules Clarified



## Update

A couple of weeks ago, we learned more about the EPA Order regarding the sale of the over-the-top dicamba products XtendiMax, Engenia & Tavium.

### Grower Applied:

Farmers applying XtendiMax, Engenia or Tavium themselves must have an invoice for these products dated on or before May 21st, 2024! If you haven't already done so, please stop in and pay for your Xtendimax ASAP!! This is NOT Pre-Pay. You will receive an invoice, on the spot, for products that will be picked up here.



### No Returns:

Also, we will not be able to accept returns for these three products. Once a container, including a shuttle, is in your possession, it is yours! You may not return these products. So, figure your acres very close and order and take only what you need. If you require assistance with calculating your needs, please let us know immediately.

### AgLand Custom Applied:

As in recent years, custom application must occur prior to June 20th, 2024, and within the hours and weather conditions set forth in the most recent version of the label. Once the application is complete, you will be invoiced. Bear in mind that it is our goal to run out of these products on or before June 20<sup>th</sup>. We are not inclined to be in long-term possession of

products that cannot be used or sold legally after June 20<sup>th</sup>.

### Avoid Trouble:

The companies that produce these three products have already stopped manufacturing them for domestic (USA) use. There are likely to be some farmers who will try to buy a two-year supply. This is an extremely risky business since there is no guarantee that anyone will be able

to legally apply these over-the-top dicamba based products in 2025 and beyond. Doing so could result in extreme fines and very high settlement amounts with your neighbors who did not grow Dicamba Tolerant Crops.

*Act Quickly:*

We would like to process all dicamba over-the-top orders, regardless of who is going to apply it, before planting season begins.
